Medical Services and First Aid

For the further protection in the unlikely event of an incident, GCS will provide first aid kits in each Superintendents truck and the GCS office trailer that will be stocked with routine medical supplies. The contents of these first aid kits will be checked by the Superintendents each month to ensure they contain the proper supplies.

First Aid, CPR, and Bloodborne Pathogen training will also be provided for all Superintendents on each site and at least one other person that will be identified during initial safety orientation.

Emergency phone numbers will be posted by the phones in each GCS trailer and in the cab of GCS trucks. If the site is in a remote location, a map to the local immediate care facility will be utilized.

Immediate medical services will be provided by Union Hospital Occupational Medicine. If an emergency warrants a higher level of treatment, then the nearest emergency room should be utilized. GCS employees will not move or relocate a severely injured employee, rather wait for the trained emergency responders to arrive.
